- The IQAC committee critically reviewed the API form submitted by all faculty members. It has been decided that faculties should be encouraged for their personal and professional development.
- The IQAC committee recommended to organize an international webinar series on Artificial Intelligence. The responsibility was assigned to the pharmacognosy department in association with the IQAC cell to conduct a webinar in second term of academic year 2021-2022.
- The committee has recognized the following major areas to be contributed by every faculty members
 - Identification of slow learner and advanced learner for all years of study for B. Pharm and D. Pharm program.
 - The faculty members should assess the learning levels of the students and organize special programs accordingly.
 - Attain 100% utilization of the digital learning platforms (Moodle/MS-team) by all teaching faculty and students.
 - The faculty members should also utilize the ICT-enabled tools such as Flipped classroom, Jigsaw technique for the effective teaching-learning process.
 - All faculty members should update their knowledge by registering to the NITTT modules of AICTE. It is mandatory for all assistant professors and associate professors to successfully complete the eight modules of NITTT.
 - The student-centric method such as Think-Pair-Share, Educational games, Buzz session, inquiry-based learning, and project-based learning should be implemented as per demands of core subject and student interest.
 - Register and complete at least 01 Faculty Development Program / Workshop / Short Term Training Program (not less than 5 days) sponsored by AICTE or recognized body by all teaching faculty per year.

- Faculties should publish research or review articles in journals well indexed with Scopus, Elsevier, PubMed, Thomson Reuters, or Web of Science – Emerging Sources Citation.
- Efforts to be taken by faculties to write reference books or book chapters with reputed National or International publishers such as CRC Press, Apple Academic Press, Elsevier, Nirali Prakashan, Springer, etc.
- Application of research proposals should be submitted to various government and non-government funding agencies for research grants.
- Development of e-content for respective subjects assigned to faculty members.
- Co-curricular and extracurricular development of the students.
- It was decided to organize 01-02 guest lectures for students by every department to improve the scientific knowledge and soft skill of students, in turn, enhance their employability.
- Training and Placement cell is directed to approach the core pharmaceutical industry for mega placement drive.
- The project guide of the undergraduate student should undertake quality work for a three-month full-time research project during the 8th semester for all final year B. Pharm students.
- The project coordinator assists students to publish their data in a UGC care journal or open access journal to promote the research environment in the institute.
- The institute is eligible to apply for NAAC after the completion of six years (i.e. two batches of students graduated) in September 2022. On this ground, the appointed NAAC coordinator is asked to submit the roadmap of the institute for application as per SSR guidelines.
- Committee members review the status of documentation as per guidelines of SSR critically.


