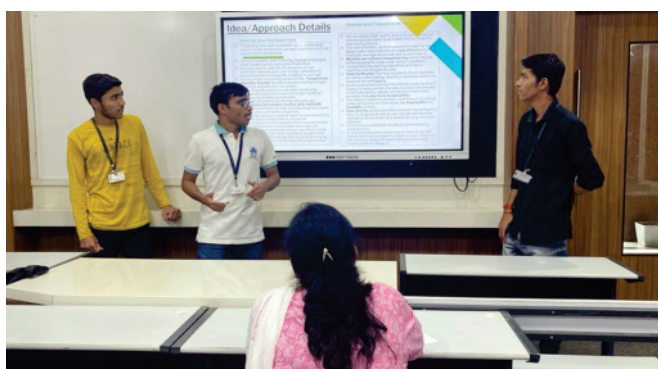
Deeksha Rambha 2023

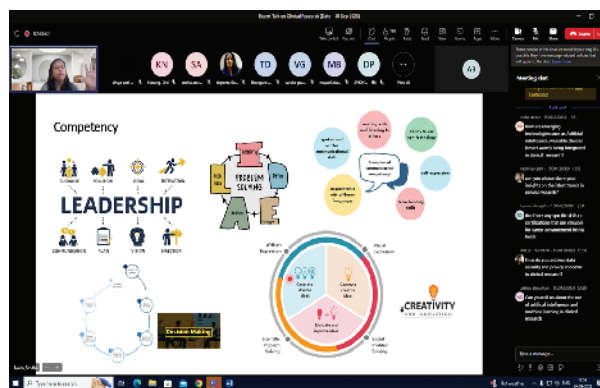
Avishkar

Meri Mati Mera Desh

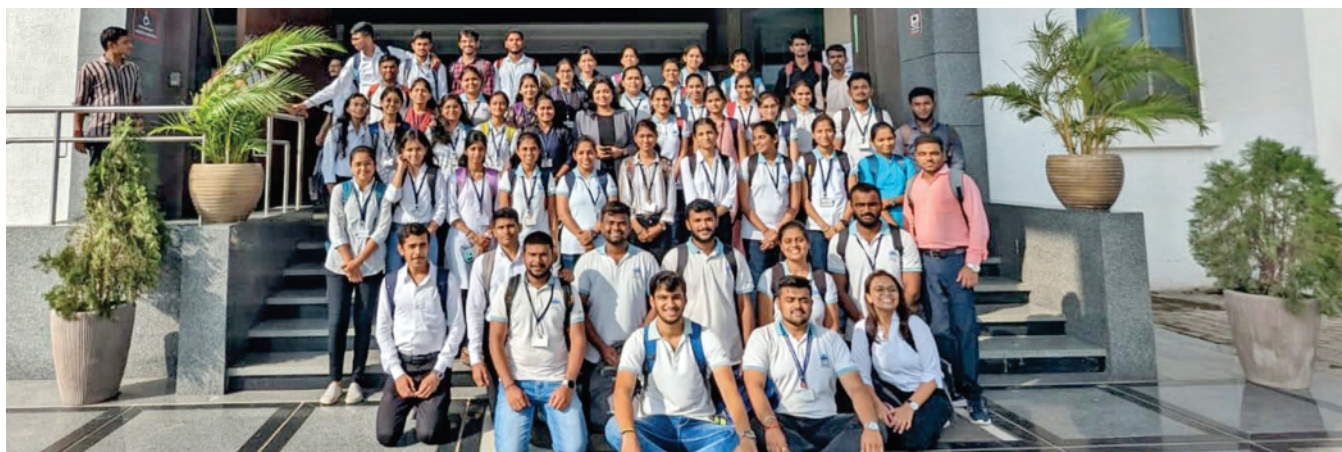

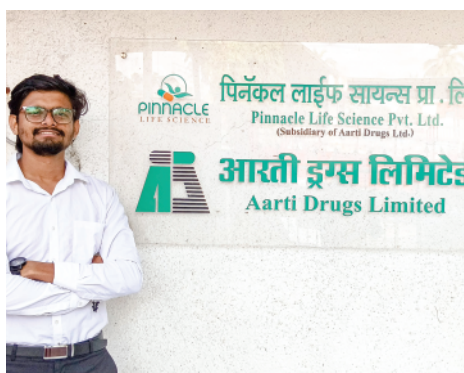
Mock Aptitude test: TCS Sigma Hiring | 6th Nov 2023 to 8th Nov 2023
